Practice

I am a Textile Artist specialising in free machine embroidery, hand stitching and mending based in Melbourne. I explore my surroundings and interpret what I see through the medium of embroidery. In my works composition, I combine light, colour, shape and texture to recreate images that inspire me. My work has been exhibited in Australia and the United Kingdom.

My practice engages with the environment recreating the images and shapes in my embroidered works in both 2D and 3D form. Photos are the starting point as I explore my subject matter onto fabric, painting with a needle and thread. Much of my work portrays my concerns surrounding climate change and the treatment of asylum seekers. I find textiles to be a perfect medium to express my thoughts using hand and machine stitching.

The majority of my work incorporates upcycled or reclaimed materials. Working with found materials I find the joy is the unexpected uses that can be found for them. I love this unpredictability and enjoy the inventiveness necessary to transform them. The choice of materials can also be a key part of the story. The materials not only highlight a need to address the amount of waste we produce, but also contributes to the story, things with a history that have been discarded and might otherwise end up in landfill.

I teach workshops passing on the core skills to enable mending, reclaiming, upcycling materials along with embroidery workshops. It is a core part of my practice along with my work promoting and facilitating community arts projects and sustainable practices.
